

RCCSP Skippers' Certification Class

Class Length: 8 hrs; on Sat. or as coordinated.

Class Size: Minimum of three (3), maximum of four (4)

Fee: \$125,

Prerequisite: Successfully completion of beginning and intermediate sailing

This class is a validation of the skills that you have learned through the beginning and intermediate classes. You will be tested on your proficiency to tack and jibe in a crisp, accurate manner, steer the boat, execute a proper crew overboard drill, reef the mainsail, general boat handling skills and docking. Additionally, you will receive an orientation on outboard gas and inboard diesel engines, VHF radio usage, preventing going aground and use of an emergency tiller.

Class Length: 15 hrs; four weekends, 3 hrs. 45 min. per session, weekday evening 3 hrs. 45 min.

Class Size: Minimum of three (3), maximum of five (5)

Fee: \$150, which includes the course book

In beginning sailing, you'll master sailing's most essential skills: how to steer a boat, trim its sail and execute sailing maneuvers such as tacking and jibing. You'll also learn about controlling sail shape and navigation aids, how to enter and leave a dock, how to tie several common sailing knots, useful in every day life, the rules of the road on inland waters and water safety.

Class Size: Minimum of three (3), maximum of four (4)

Fee: \$175

Prerequisite: Successful completion of beginning sailing or equivalent experience

In intermediate sailing, you'll build on the skills mastered in beginning sailing. Additionally, you'll learn: to do a pre-sail check; to use sail shape controls; execute a man overboard drill; to shorten sail; to anchor under sail and power; to tie additional nautical knots; navigation; and about tides & currents.
